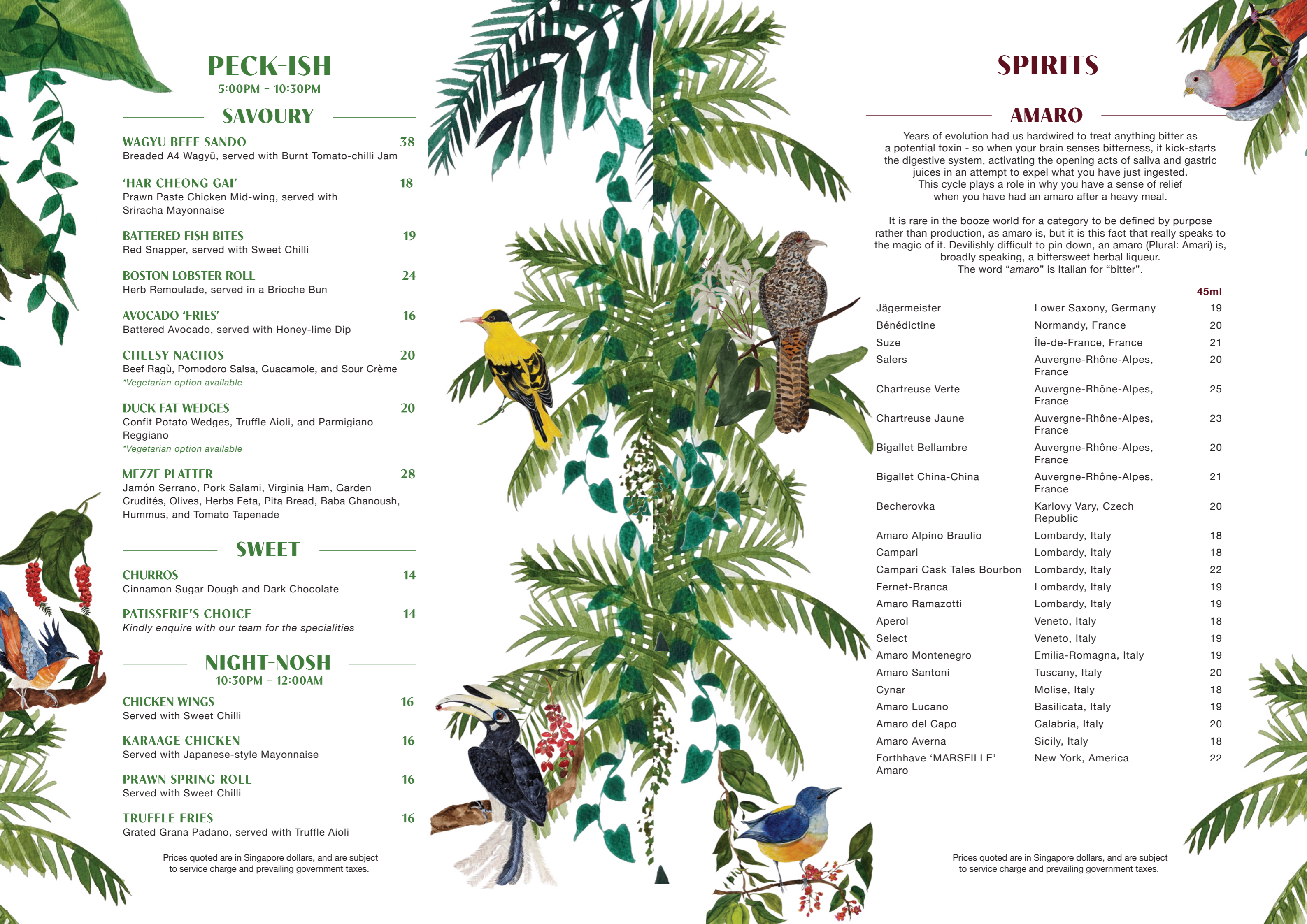
This cycle plays a role in why you have a sense of relief when you have had an amaro after a heavy meal.

With its origins deeply rooted in history and its diverse array of flavour profiles, it has evolved from a medicinal remedy to a refined libation of choice for connoisseurs and cocktail enthusiasts alike.

Originating as a medicinal liquor made by monks and alchemists across Europe, it is primarily made from grain-based spirits, such as barley, corn, rye, or wheat. Its key flavouring agent is juniper berries, providing the spirit its signature “piney” or “Christmas tree-like” taste.

VODKA

Vodka originated from the grain-growing regions of western Russia, Belarus, Lithuania, Ukraine, and Poland. Its exact origins are frequently the source of bitter dispute between the Russians and the Poles, who both argue that vodka originated from their country. Both claim it as their national spirit.

It is a clear spirit which can be produced from anything containing starch or sugar – including potatoes, sugar beet molasses, and most commonly, grain. The name vodka is a diminutive form of the Slavic word “voda” (Water), interpreted as “waterkin”.

AGAVE

Archaeological evidence from 300 A.D. suggests that agave was already important in the lives and culture of the Mexican Indians. They revered the plant as a deity and personified it through Mayahuel, the goddess of fertility who was endowed with 400 breasts to feed her 400 sons.

Agave is a perennial succulent that grows in the arid regions of North and South America. The plants take eight to 12 years to fully mature, and flower only once in their lifetime. The base of the agave plant is called the pina, which is where the agave stores its food source and the part of the plant that is used to make mezcal and tequila.

SUGARCANE

Sugarcane originally comes from Asia, where it has been cultivated since time immemorial. The plant spread through Persia, Syria, Egypt, and Sicily in the seventh century. Rum is produced from sugarcane hence its history is intertwined with the economics of that species of grass and the slave trade that emerged to service the industry that grew around its cultivation and processing.

The spectrum of rum ranges from light, vodka-like extra-light white rums to characterful cognac-like aged rums. It can be hard to distinguish between all the different types of sugarcane spirits when first starting your rum journey, with many variants pre-dating Caribbean Rum by a century or more.

WHISKY

The word 'whisky' derives from the Gaelic "uisque beatha", meaning "water of life". The distillation process spread to Scotland and Ireland in the 15th century via Alexandrian Greeks, Medieval Arabs, and Latin Europeans. Today, whiskies are distilled around the world, including America, Canada, Australia, and Japan.

This spirit was used "for medicinal purposes" for some time, but started to become widely adopted as a beverage of choice and a good way to use up excess grains, keeping them safe from the rats' clutches. Each country traditionally produces a different style of whisky using slightly different methods. However, all whiskies are made from grain.

BRANDY

Brandy comes from the Dutch word “*brandewijn*” meaning “Burnt wine.” Most brandies are distilled from fermented grape juice (i.e. Wine). However, they can also be distilled from other fruits – notably plums, apricots, apples, and cherries.

Like other spirits, brandy is thought to have been originally drunk for its medicinal properties - and the folk belief that brandy is a cure-all still exists, where it is administered for shock or exposure in defiance of current medical thinking.
